Please note, depending on the type of community engagement requested, there will be a fee incurred.

- Lived experience speakers are \$250 per hour and are trained individuals from a refugee/ asylum seeker background. They share their personal stories and challenges of seeking safety in Australia.
- CARAD guest speakers are \$100 per 30 minutes. They are trained professionals with experience working with Asylum Seekers and Refugees.
- Asylum Seeker Simulation Workshops are \$250 per 90 minutes. They consist of relevant and current information about refugees, including case studies, examples, and resources.
- Presentation, Interviews and Participation are \$100 per 30 minutes.
